On the 1st Tuesday of every month the Ladies meet at 10:00. The group's goal is to help meet the needs of our commended workers

abroad (Zambia). We supply good clean clothing, men's, ladies, baby's and children, shoes, plus sheets, bedding, craft supplies, Sunday School Supplies, and School Supplies. Many hygiene bags with a tooth brush, toothpaste & face cloth, soap, comb, small Kleenex and wordless books, & prizes.

We send Quebec some of our heavy clothing for Jessie Trembly's clothing project, at her assembly.

When we receive unsuitable items these are given to Value Village.

We have been asked to help with some Island families in need along with helping our refugee family with new and used clothing, boots, sneakers, winter jackets and furniture .

We have helped Dale & Margaret Gallagher with their refugee closet at Faith Bible Church.

Our Campbell's Soup labels go to the School for the deaf children at home and abroad.

The used postage stamps (USA & Foreign) are sold and proceeds go to Doris Pitman for her translation work. Canadian Tire money, goes to Quebec for full time workers car expenses. Old greeting cards for our wordless books, we will cut and sort.

We can't do it without the men. They carry boxes, put up tables, deliver to transport company and unload boxes. Thank's boys for giving of your time!!
