



Hello my name is **Jody Thomas**, I attended Charlottetown Bible Chapel from Jan 2001 to August 2004 and still love to visit when I get home to the Island. Since July of 2010 I have been doing full time Christian ministry in **Pretoria South Africa**. I work through an organization called Nieucommunities. I do evangelism, discipleship and leadership coaching with refugees or asylum seekers from Zimbabwe in the inner city of Pretoria and surrounding areas. When opportunity arises I try to help these folks in practical ways like, find a job, do up a resume, and navigate immigration and social services in the city.

Zimbabwe is a country north of South Africa, south of Zambia, it used to be one of the most developed African countries in the Sub-Sarah but since the 90's it has had a huge economic decline and a lot of political clashes and tensions. So a lot of Zimbabweans have been crossing the border, (sometimes illegally) into South Africa to look for work and or a better life. However they are often not welcomed by the locals in South Africa and experience a lot prejudices and full blown racism such xenophobic attacks (violent attacks on foreigners).

<u>Struggles:</u> Watching my friends suffer and having to trust them to God, when it is beyond my help- being so far from family in Canada-building trust in the community- praying against witchcraft.

<u>Praises:</u> God's financial and relational provision for me while being here, over and above what I could of asked for- Seeing the gospel really change people's lives, especially when they have come out of some pretty bad company which is the case for some of the young gentlemen I have been journeying with.

<u>Prayer requests:</u> Please prayer for my own discipleship, spiritual growth, and protection from street crime and witch craft- Please pray for my forth coming marriage this year to my fiancé Francine- Pray that things in Zimbabwe will turn around so that that my friends in South Africa can go home.
