### Pray for Persecuted Believers – Voice of the Martyrs Prayer Guide

*In many countries Christians are harassed, discriminated against, slandered, unjustly accused, summarily arrested (sometimes only for three or four hours, sometimes for a few days), and sometimes imprisoned, exiled or killed. Families are divided, extended families disown believers, and their communities often deny them food, shelter or comfort.*

*Pray that in these circumstances these Christians will remain faithful and strong in their belief in Jesus Christ as Lord despite psychological pressures and physical abuse.*

*Pray that they will be able to forgive those who persecute them and those who fail to support them.*

*Pray that they will have courage, strength, wisdom and an unshakeable trust in the sovereignty and love of God. Pray that they will know the truth of Romans 8:28-39.*

*Pray for humility, that they may follow Jesus' example in times of injustice and false accusations (Isaiah 53:7).*

*Pray for joy when suffering physical distress in mind or body (Matthew 5:11-12, Romans 5:3).*

*Pray for peace, especially for those with responsibilities for dependents (1 Peter 5:7). Pray for patience when waiting for trial and sentencing decisions.*

*Pray that they will continue to be bold in their witness, proclaiming the Gospel with clarity, being ready to give a reason for the hope that is within them.*
