Pray for Persecuted Believers – Voice of the Martyrs Prayer Guide – continued (part 3)  
In many countries Christians are harassed, discriminated against, slandered, unjustly accused, summarily arrested (sometimes only for three or four hours, sometimes for a few days), and sometimes imprisoned, exiled or killed. Families are divided, extended families disown believers, and their communities often deny them food, shelter or comfort.

Pray for the children of those imprisoned. Children are often forced to endure hardship while a mother or father is imprisoned and often suffer considerable trauma. Pressures from outside the family unit can also be intolerable for young children.

Some children may not remember their parents due to long prison sentences and so find it difficult to feel a relationship exists between them.

Some children can be taken into State custody in order to receive "corrective teaching" (especially in China and North Korea). Pray that these children will overcome the bitterness of having parents choose Christ over love for them. Pray that they will know that "in all things, God works for the good of those that love Him" (Romans 8:28).

Pray that they will come to know the love of the heavenly Father who gave up His Son for them (Romans 8:32).
