### The Power of Prayer – Voice of the Martyrs – Praying for Bible, Scripture and Christian literature distribution:

The provision of the Scriptures in the mother tongue of each people in the world is fundamental to the task of world evangelization. But good teaching materials, discipleship materials, evangelistic tracts, Christian biographies and study aids are also needed.

Of the world's 6700 languages, over 4000 languages still have a need for New Testament translation work.

Pray for the work of Wycliffe Bible Translators/SIL and others in their dedication to translating the New Testament into all the languages of the world. Pray for translators, advisors, support personnel and literacy workers (many peoples do not have a written language and of those that do, very small percentages can read or write.)

Pray that scriptures will be produced in minority languages.

Pray for the printing of Scriptures. Pray for the funds to purchase suitable paper. Pray for those who operate the printing presses and associated machinery.

Pray for the establishment of centres of Scripture distribution in restricted countries, and in countries that are rebuilding after war, political crises and the fall of communism.

Pray for the development of good Bible correspondence courses and Theological Education by Extension courses. Pray that students, many of them studying in secret, will be motivated and disciplined, and have an openness to the Holy Spirit and ultimately, be integrated into fellowship with other believers.

Pray for the couriers who take the Scriptures and other Christian literature into restricted countries. Pray for their safety and protection, for smooth and undetected passage through customs, and for discrete delivery of their literature to spiritually hungry believers.
