### Pray for Persecuted Believers – Voice of the Martyrs Prayer Guide – continued

*In many countries Christians are harassed, discriminated against, slandered, unjustly accused, summarily arrested (sometimes only for three or four hours, sometimes for a few days), and sometimes imprisoned, exiled or killed. Families are divided, extended families disown believers, and their communities often deny them food, shelter or comfort.*

*Pray for the wives of those imprisoned. With the absence of the breadwinner, the responsibilities for caring and feeding of the family falls on the wife. Sometimes the wife is forced to provide food for her husband in prison (often the case in Vietnam). If she is also arrested, then together they have to bear the anguish of leaving often quite young children to fend for themselves.*

*Many wives suffer intimidation from the police and ostracism from their communities when their husbands are imprisoned. Pray for them in times of loneliness and distress, pray they will know God's presence, comfort and strength (2 Cor. 1:3-10)*

*Pray for the children of those imprisoned. Children are often forced to endure hardship while a mother or father is imprisoned and often suffer considerable trauma. Pressures from outside the family unit can also be intolerable for young children*
