We can read His Word and learn how to live according to His instructions.

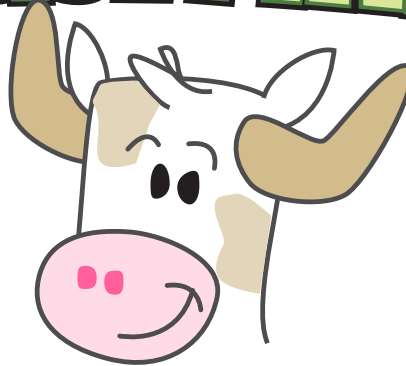
And we can thank Him.

- A club year has approximately 30-32 weeks – so if you complete two sections a week, you will finish your book.

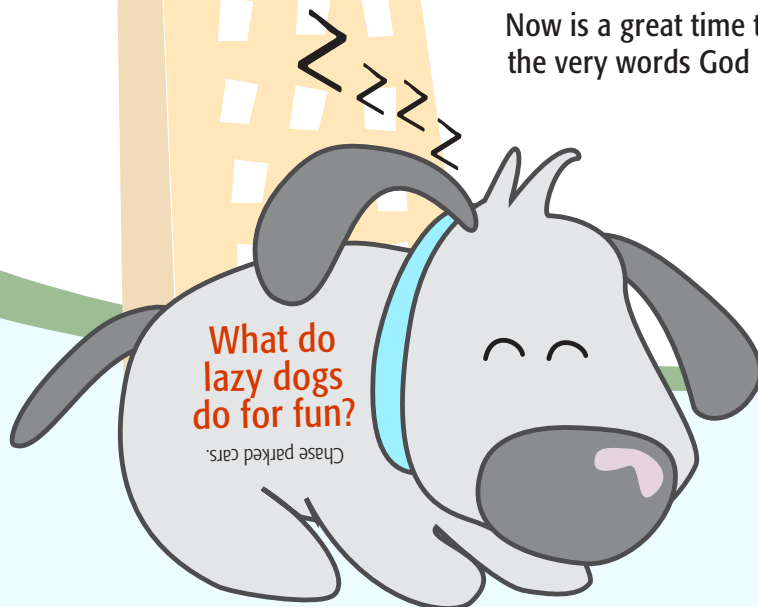

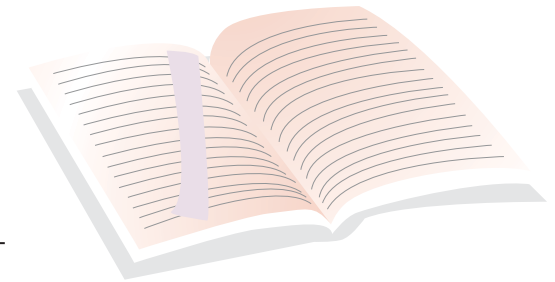

BOOK FACTS

- Approximately 190,000 books are published in the U.S. each year. The United Kingdom is another country that prints a lot of books – some years they print even more than the U.S.
- The outside edge of the book is called the spine.
- Electronic sales of books are growing rapidly and are already greater than the sales of printed books in some stores.
- A biography is a book about someone written by another person. An autobiography is a book that someone writes about himself.
- During Bible times, people read from papyrus scrolls rather than books as we know them.

BOOK RECIPE

Here's a fun dessert idea. Bake a cake for the next special occasion at your house (of course, you'll want Dad or Mom's permission for this). Frost the two shorter sides of the cake and one of the longer sides with white frosting. Frost the rest of the cake with a solid-colored frosting.

Then decorate the top of the cake as a book. If you're baking a birthday cake, you could choose a title such as: *The Story of My Sister* or *Emma's Story* (with you as the author).

Or you could decorate the cake in honor of a soccer win or art award: *Ten Tips to Winning a Soccer Game* or *Painting for a Prize*. Be creative and have fun.

Run a fork along the white frosting on the sides so that it looks like pages.
