OVERVIEW:

These Bible videos are from the creator of VeggieTales. They take your kids through the Bible in a fun, kid-friendly, but VERY content-rich way.

Stretching from Genesis to Jesus, Paul, and Revelation, each DVD is a fast-paced and humorous "show" about what's in particular book(s) of the Bible and what they mean to us today.

Each DVD has two 26 minute episodes led by a cast of fun "muppet quality" characters interacting with Phil Vischer.

Each episode is full of humor, narrated animations, creative graphics, 'live' performers interacting with the cast, bunches of short jingly teaching songs, explanations of scripture concepts, kid-friendly Bible background, and lots of life application.

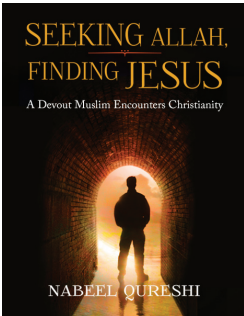
The content is geared toward Sunday School and teaching (which isn't always the case with Vischer's previous Veggie Tales efforts).

Each DVD in this series reinforces the series' and Bible's overarching theme of "God's Rescue Plan for us." The characters and Phil Vischer regularly revisit this theme and show how each book's story fits into that plan. These theological concepts are explained and repeated for effect through illustration, animation and song.

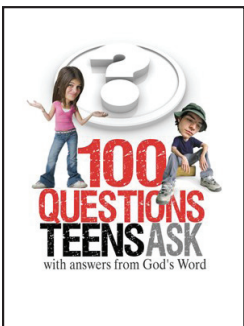

However, despite his objections to Christianity, it was the friendship of Christians, the historical facts of the life of Jesus, and divine revelation through a dream and vision that convinced Nabeel of the truth of the Gospel. Nabeel's testimony will deepen your understanding of American Muslims and draw you closer to Jesus as you consider the amazing ways He works today.

Growing up, Nabeel never thought he would consider turning from his family's deeply held beliefs in Islam. It was his whole world, his identity. Yet, as he grew into a young man earnestly seeking for God to speak into his life, he was surprised by what he found. What he found was a growing question about the divinity of Jesus, which lead ultimately to his conversion to Christianity (christian-book.com).
