All financial gifts have to be in by midnight of Dec. 31st for the <u>2015</u> <u>tax receipt year.</u> "Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night ... So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, "Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us." ... Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them." (Luke 2:8, 15, 20)

It is likely that the shepherds in Luke 2 were not just ordinary shepherds. Because the shepherds' fields of Bethlehem were so close to Jerusalem, many scholars believe that these were temple shepherds who raised the sheep that would be used at the temple sacrifice. If so, this announcement becomes an anticipation of the proclamation of John the Baptist when he first saw Jesus: *"Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)*. These sheep destined for sacrifice would be replaced by God's perfect Lamb—His one and only Son.
